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Prayers of Gratitude for November

November 1 - **Verse:** The Lord is my strength and shield. I trust him with all my heart. He helps me, and my heart is filled with joy. I burst out in songs of thanksgiving. *Psalm 28:7* **Reflection:** Think about one person that has taught you about unconditional love in the past or present. Thank God for that person.

November 2 - Verse: Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts. *Colossians 3: 16* **Reflection:** Think back to the worst period of your life and list three ways life is better now. Tell God about them and thank him for his faithfulness.

November 3 - Verse: Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. *Philippians 6:6-7* **Reflection:** Think about a challenging person in your life and find three things to celebrate about them. Tell God about your struggles with them and thank God for their presence in your life.

November 4 - Verse: Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand. *Isaiah 41:10* **Reflection:** Think about three reasons you are grateful for living in this country. Tell God about them.

November 5 - Verse: Since everything God created is good, we should not reject any of it but receive it with thanks. For we know it is made acceptable by the word of God and prayer. *1 Timothy 4:4-5* **Reflection:** Think back on someone who has forgiven you for a mistake you made in the past. Thank God for these moments of grace.

November 6 - Verse: We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed, but not driven to despair. We are hunted down, but never abandoned by God. We get knocked down, but we are not destroyed. *2 Corinthians 4:8-9* **Reflection:** Think about three things that come easy to you but may be challenging for others. Thank God for the gifts He has given you.

November 7 - **Verse:** Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness. *Colossians 2:7* **Reflection:** Think about three difficult parts of your life which turned out to be blessings. Thank God for His wisdom.

November 8 - **Verse:** Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous. And when we take your gifts to those who need them, they will thank God. *2 Corinthians 9:11* **Reflection:** Think about three things that were beautiful today. Thank God for His creation.

November 9 - Verse: We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation. And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love. *Romans 5:3-5* **Reflection:** Name three of your basic needs that were met today. Thank God for providing you with your daily bread.

November 10 - Verse: Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart. *Colossians 4:2* **Reflection:** Are you a morning person or a night owl? Think about three things you love about this time of day. Thank God for the light and the darkness.

November 11 - **Verse:** I will praise you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all the marvelous things you have done. *Psalm 9:1* **Reflection:** Explore three things you can start doing today to express your gratitude towards others. Ask God for help.

November 12 - **Verse:** Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise. Give thanks to him and praise his name. For the Lord is good. His unfailing love continues forever, and his faithfulness continues to each generation. *Psalm 100:4-5* **Reflection:** Think about your favorite location in your house and why you like it. Thank God for His comfort.

November 13 - **Verse:** Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus. *1 Thessalonians 5:16-18* **Reflection:** Think about three things that bring a smile to your face. Thank God for laughter.

November 14 – Verse: Whatever is good and perfect is a gift coming down to us from God our Father, who created all the lights in the heavens. He never changes or casts a shifting shadow. *James 1:17* **Reflection:** Think about three things that you take for granted which might not be available to people in other parts of the world. Thank God for the opportunities that He has given you.

November 15 – Verse: Dear brothers and sisters, we can't help but thank God for you, because your faith is flourishing and your love for one another is growing. *2 Thessalonians 1:3* **Reflection:** Think of a time when someone went out of their way to help you. Thank God for the helpers.

November 16 – Verse: Then we your people, the sheep of your pasture, will thank you forever and ever, praising your greatness from generation to generation. *Psalm 79:13* **Reflection:** Think about three things that make you happy to be alive. Thank God for giving you the gift of life.

November 17 – Verse: And whatever you do or say, do it as a representative of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through him to God the Father. *Colossians 3:17* **Reflection:** Think about three lovely qualities from people you admire. How can you incorporate them into your life? Thank God for their example and ask Him to help you to change and grow towards Him.

November 18 - **Verse**: In his kindness God called you to share in his eternal glory by means of Christ Jesus. So, after you have suffered a little while, he will restore, support, and strengthen you, and he will place you on a firm foundation. *1 Peter 5:10* **Reflection:** Think about your favorite quote or a bit of wisdom that you frequently share with others. Thank God for the gift of knowledge.

November 19 – Verse: Such things were written in the Scriptures long ago to teach us. And the Scriptures give us hope and encouragement as we wait patiently for God's promises to be fulfilled. *Romans 15:4* **Reflection:** Think about three things that have strengthened your character and made you who you are today. Thank God for the gift of right judgment.

November 20 – Verse: The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning. I say to myself, "The Lord is my inheritance; therefore, I will hope in him!" *Lamentations 3:* 22-24 **Reflection:** Think about a recent time when you truly felt at peace. If this is a struggle to recall, reflect on why that is. Thank God for His never-ending love.

November 21 - **Verse**: For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. *Jeremiah 29:11* **Reflection:** Think about three positive things in your life that you did not have five years ago. Thank God for these blessings.

November 22 – **Verse:** But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint. *Isaiah 40:31* **Reflection:** Think about something you did recently for the first time that brought you joy. Thank God for this experience.

November 23 – Verse: I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called—his holy people who are his rich and glorious inheritance. *Ephesians 1:18* **Reflection:** Think about which artist, author, or musician brings you great joy. Thank God for the gifts He has given to others. *Continued on next page* **November 24** - **Verse**: Rejoice in our confident hope. Be patient in trouble, and keep on praying. *Romans 12:12* **Reflection:** Think about three things you are looking forward to in the next year. Thank God for the exhilarating feeling of anticipation.

November 25 – **Verse**: Everyone will live in peace and prosperity, enjoying their own grapevines and fig trees, for there will be nothing to fear. The Lord of Heaven's Armies has made this promise! *Micah 4:4* **Reflection:** Think about three things in the current season that you are grateful for. Thank God for the four seasons.

November 26 – Verse: Give, and you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full—pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, running over, and poured into your lap. The amount you give will determine the amount you get back. *Luke 6:38* **Reflection:** Think about three family traditions that have formed you positively. Thank God for the people that made these traditions happen.


November 27 – Verse: But thank God! He has made us his captives and continues to lead us along in Christ's triumphal procession. Now he uses us to spread the knowledge of Christ everywhere, like a sweet perfume. 2 *Corinthians 2:14* **Reflection:** Think about three opportunities that you are grateful for. Thank God for them.

November 28 – Verse: Praise the name of God forever and ever, for he has all wisdom and power. He controls the course of world events; he removes kings and sets up other kings. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the scholars. *Daniel 2:20-21* **Reflection:** Think about three pieces of positive news from today. Thank God for the good things happening around you.

November 29 – Verse: So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the Lord your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you. *Deuteronomy 31:6* **Reflection:** Think about three things you will do today to care for your physical well-being. Thank God for the gift of your strong, amazing body.

November 30 – Verse: And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful. *Colossians 3:15* Reflection: Think about three things you will do today to care for your mental well-being. Thank God for the gift of your emotions.



Requests for absentee ballots may be made:

1 by requesting a ballot on line from Maine.gov

2. in *writing*, delivered to the office or mailed to Town of Edgecomb, P.O. Box 139, Edgecomb, ME 04556.

3. by faxing a request to 882-7381.

4. by calling the Town Office Tuesdays 1-5PM or Thursdays 1-7 PM, 882-7018.

You may also call the Town Clerk at 350-0963, at any other time.

5. or *you may pick up* an Absentee Ballot Request at the Town Office Tuesdays 1-5PM or Thursdays 1 -7PM.

Email requests cannot be accepted. Last day to request a ballot is Thursday November 3, 2022 by 7pm, otherwise you will have to call the town clerk to see if you're eligible for a special circumstances request .

Your requested ballot will be mailed to you, unless you pick it up at the office. **It must be returned to the office by 8PM Tuesday, November 8, 2022**. You may also vote at the office Tuesdays 1-5PM and Thursdays 1-7PM.

To vote in person, Polls will be open Tuesday, November 8, from 8AM- 8PM, at the Town Hall.
